For what purposes do we collect, hold, use and disclose your personal information?

We collect, hold, use and disclose your personal information for the following purposes:

- to provide products and services to you and to send communications requested by you;
- to answer enquiries and provide information or advice about existing and new products or services;
- to provide you with access to protected areas of our website;
- to assess the performance of the website and to improve the operation of the website;
- to conduct business processing functions including providing personal information to our group of companies and its related bodies corporate, our related bodies corporate, and contractors, service providers or other third parties;
- for administrative, planning, product or service development, marketing (including direct marketing), quality control, survey and research purposes, of group of companies and its related bodies corporate, related bodies corporate, contractors or service providers;
- to provide your updated personal information to our group companies and its related bodies corporate, related bodies corporate, contractors or service providers;
- to update our records and keep your contact details up to date;
- to process and respond to any complaint made by you; and
- to comply with any law, rule, regulation, lawful and binding determination, decision or direction of a regulator, or in co-operation with any governmental authority of any country (or political sub-division of a country).

What happens if we can't collect your personal information?

To whom may we disclose your information?

We may disclose your personal information to:

- any organisation for any authorised purpose with your express consent.
